Laurel Lake provides year-round enjoyment for its visitors and guests by way of boating and fishing (public boat ramp), swimming at the town beach, the annual cance and kayak race, vacation rentals, and visits with family and friends. Guests to the lake can be environmental caretakers by simply showing respect for its natural surroundings and wildlife while visiting and enjoying it. Simple things like following our boating rules posted at the public boat ramp, refraining from putting chemicals and harmful items into the lake water and around its shoreline, making sure that entering boats are "clean, drained, and dry" and free of hitchhiking invasives, picking up and properly disposing of trash, respecting "town resident only" use of the town beach, and leaving the place the way you found it are all good lake caretaking activities for visitors.
